18-I Lions Hall of Fame

Sponsored by the 18-I PDG Association

ELIGIBILITY

All nominees living or deceased must have a minimum of ten (10) years of active Lion Service. Induction into the District Lions Hall of Fame signifies a Lion's noteworthy contributions to the ideals of Lionism through the Lions Club, District, and community; it is not intended to be a longevity award. All living nominees must be current members in good standing of a District 18-I Lions Club.

CLUB NOMINATING PROCEDURES

- A letter of nomination of not more than two double-spaced typewritten pages setting forth the individual's accomplishments in Lionism, home Lions Club, and community; Lions Awards and recognitions earned with dates received; and leadership positions held in Lionism including dates, must be submitted to the President of the District 18-I Past District Governor's Association, IPDG Dr. Thomson Varghese, drlionmjfdg21@yahoo.com, postmarked no later than 45 days prior to the Third District Cabinet Meeting. The letter must include a statement of intention of the nominee to be present at the presentation ceremony during the Third Cabinet Meeting and must be signed by the Club President or Club Hall of Fame Committee Chair.
- The nominating club must agree in writing to provide the necessary funds to purchase the plaque for each nominee selected. Clubs will be billed by the PDG Association for each nominee selected.

SELECTION PROCESS

A committee of the three (3) most recent active Past District Governors, with the most recent serving as chair, will review all nominations and select nominees for induction into the District Hall of Fame. The chair shall promulgate a list of inductees to the President of the PDG Association. Note: The selection committee reserves the right to limit the number of Lions honored each year. Lions who are not selected may be nominated again.

INDUCTION CEREMONY

The President shall coordinate with the District Governor to ensure an appropriate induction ceremony is held in conjunction with the District's Third Regular Cabinet Meeting. The President is responsible for publicizing the Hall of Fame, coordinating nominations from participating clubs, and procuring the plaques.

NOMINATIONS CATEGORIES

• All District 18-I Past International Directors, living or deceased, may be automatically selected provided their club nominates and agrees to purchase the plaque.

• Each Lions Club of District 18-I may submit two (2) nominations annually to be considered for induction into the District 18-I Hall of Fame.

District Awards 2023-2024

- **L.H.L.** (Lions Helping Lions) Award Certificate to be presented to all clubs who have one or more members assist another club with a service project or fundraiser.
- **F.O.C.U.S.** (Fellowship of Caring United Servant-Leaders) Award To be presented to all clubs who design and complete at least one new service project during Lions Year 2023-2023. Project must be reported on MyLion to qualify.
- **S.M.I.L.E.** (Service, Membership, Integrity, Leos/Leadership, Enthusiasm) Award Nominated by fellow club members, this Lion exemplifies at least one of these traits daily.
- **O.G.C.** (Order of the Golden Chain) Certificate to be presented to all clubs who have at least one member achieve this award.

Proud Lion Award – Presented to each member who joined Lions after 4/30/23 and their sponsor/mentor. The new Lion needs to complete the following within six (6) months of joining:

- Attend a Club Board Meeting
- Visit another club
- Participate in a club project
- Attend a Zone or District meeting

Club Secretary must submit a statement showing dates achieved.

- **CLUB "NET 2" AWARD:** Given to ALL Lions Clubs who have a net membership gain of two (2) or more members between July 1, 2023, and June 30, 2024. Awards will be given at the first district Cabinet meeting in July 2024
- **"4th And 3" MEMBERSHIP CAMPAIGN:** Given to ALL Lions Clubs that add at least three (3) new members during the 4th Quarter of the Lions Year (April 1st through June 30th). NOTE: Transfer members do not count. Awards will be given at the first district Cabinet meeting in July 2024.
- "NET 5" AWARD: Special award for ALL clubs that start with fewer than 20 members as of July 1, 2023, and end the year with a net gain of 5 or more.
- "ADD 5" AWARD: Any District 18-I Lions Club in good standing, that adds five (5) or more new members between July 1, 2023, and June 30, 2024, is eligible for this award.
- **MOST MEMBERS SPONSORED:** (FIRST, SECOND, AND THIRD) Given to the Lion who has sponsored the most members starting July 1, 2023 and ending June 30, 2024. These awards will be given at the first district cabinet meeting in July 2024.

LCIF CLUB DONATION EXCELLENCE: Given to ALL Lions Clubs who donate at least \$25 to LCIF beginning July 1, 2023, and before April 30, 2024. All Clubs are strongly encouraged to give as much as possible.

LIGHTHOUSE AND GA LIONS CAMP DONATION EXCELLENCE AWARD: Given to ALL Lions Clubs who donate at least \$25 to both the Lighthouse and GA Lions Camp beginning July 1, 2023, and before April 30, 2024. All Clubs are strongly encouraged to give as much as possible. Also acceptable are product and supply donations in lieu of money. Check the camp list. Record your donations in My LION.

DISTRICT GOVERNOR AWARD: Every 18-I Lions Club that adds five (5) or more new members between July 1, 2023, and June 20, 2024, will receive this special recognition from the District Governor.

SERVICE EXCELLENCE AWARDS FOR HUNGER, DIABETES, ENVIRONMENT, CHILDHOOD CANCER, AND VISION: (1st and 2nd Places per Lions Initiative – Hours of service ONLY) Given to Lions Clubs with the most service hours per Lions Initiative, recorded in MyLION, per member, during the Lions year beginning July 1, 2023, and ending April 30, 2024. In case of a tie the award will be given to the club who more regularly (monthly entry) gives service in the category. (To calculate the number credited to your club, we take the total number of service hours recorded for the appropriate Lions initiative on MyLION divided by the number of club members your club has on April 30, 2024.)

DISTRICT COMMITTEE CHAIR EXCELLENCE: Given to ALL District Chairs who accomplish the following by April 30, 2023. You must apply for this award. Applications are due to PCC Olin Newby by May 5, 2024

- Make presentations outside of Lions Clubs (schools, churches, community groups, scouts, etc.). You must show proof of such visitation.
- Submit an article regarding their Lions topic to newspapers/magazines in the local area/District. You must show proof of submission of the article.
- Submit an article regarding their Lions topic to the District newsletter/website.
- Visit and present programs to Lion Clubs in addition to their own club. You must show proof of the presentation.
- Place information on the web Facebook, Blog, YouTube, place photos in Flickr, Instagram Photos, and Twitter. You must notify PCC Olin Newby of this information placement.

ORDER OF THE GOLDEN CHAIN AWARD: Any Lion in good standing may apply for this award. Applications must be submitted no later than April 30, 2024. Download

application at our district website. Send completed form to District Chair Bonnie Linscott, bonhome@bellsouth.net. (This is a State Award given at the district meeting during the state convention.)



Lions Code of Ethics

TO SHOW my faith in the worthiness of my vocation by industrious application to the end that I may merit a reputation for quality of service.

TO SEEK success and to demand all fair remuneration or profit as my just due, but to accept no profit or success at the price of my own self-respect lost because of unfair advantage taken or because of questionable acts on my part.

TO REMEMBER that in building up my business it is not necessary to tear down another's; to be loyal to my clients or customers and true to myself.

WHENEVER a doubt arises as to the right or ethics of my position of action towards others, to resolve such doubt against myself.

TO HOLD friendship as an end and not a means. To hold that true friendship exists not on account of the service performed by one to another, but that true friendship demands nothing but accepts service in the spirit in which it is given.

ALWAYS bear in mind my obligations as a citizen to my nation, my state and my community, and to give them my unswerving loyalty in word, act and deed. To give them freely of my time, labor and means.

TO AID others by giving my sympathy to those in distress, my aid to the weak, and my substance to the needy. To be careful with my criticism and liberal with my praise; to build up and not destroy.

Lions Purpose

To Organize, charter and supervise service clubs to be known as Lions clubs.

To Coordinate the activities and standardize the administration of Lions clubs.

To Create and foster a spirit of understanding among the peoples of the world.

To Promote the principles of good government and good citizenship.

To Take an active interest in the civic, cultural, social and moral welfare of the community.

To Unite the clubs in the bonds of friendship, good fellowship and mutual understanding.

To Provide a forum for the open discussion of all matters of public interest; provided, however, that partisan politics and sectarian religion shall not be debated by club members.

To Encourage service-minded people to serve their community without personal financial reward, and to encourage efficiency and promote high ethical standards in commerce, industry, professions, public works and private endeavors.
