**District Performance – CLUBS REPORTING:**

**District L – 10 Clubs:      No GST report since July!**

Alpharetta, Atlanta Latino, Atlanta Metro, Ballground, Douglas County, Ellijay, Marietta East Cobb, Smyrna Jonquil, South Cobb, and Villa Rica Golden.

**District I – 10 Clubs:      As District I GST – this report will suffice!**

Conyers, Covington, Dawsonville, Hartwell, Loganville, Norcross, Oxford, Social Circle, Statham, and Winder Noon.

**District O – 2 Clubs:      No GST Report!**

Columbus and Macon North-West.

**District N – 8 Clubs:      Report received December 6!**

Alamo, Bellville, Hinesville, Jekyll Island, National Hills, Pooler, Richmond Hills, and Savannah.

**District N – GST Reort:**

12 clubs reported, 56 service activities and 1,060 volunteer hours. Much focus still on recoup from Hurricane Helene (HH). Some still do not have internet.

**LCI goals** – Continued work to maintain service projects / reporting by 5% - still weak on Diabetes project implementation by 5%; Advocacy Opportunity – Disaster Relief everywhere; and ONE Service Initiative strengthened by LCIF – Disaster Relief.

**Plans for Next Month** – (1) Zoom Cabinet Meeting focus – Disaster Relief and (2) Service Activities – expect many new service projects because of HH.

**District-wide Service Project** – District N adopted Legos as one of their service projects.

**District Results vs. Goals:**

1. Service Reporting Results: Still weak due to HH.

2. Comments / Concerns: Zone Chairs & Clubs: A Disaster Team has been setup with Douglas. Communication ongoing with club needs.
3. Performance against our 8 Initiatives: Clubs have reported on Hunger, Disaster, Humanitarian, Environment, Vision, Childhood Cancer, and Admin. Low activity with Diabetes and Youth. Lots of programs postponed after HH. The same service activities at the start of the year continues. Hurricane Helene will bring forth some amazing stories of service over the next few months.

## MD18 GST December 2024 Report – NOVEMBER RESULTS

LCIF recently announced a new **Vision Grant** opportunity that will support Lions-led service activities that fight blindness and preventable vision loss and/or assist people in underserved communities who are blind and visually impaired. The new grant is intended to support Lions in their work in four primary focus areas, including infrastructure development, equipment acquisition, human resource and capacity building and limited consumables. The grant builds on the legacy of the **SightFirst program**, which has enabled Lions, health care providers and organizations around the world to fight the major causes of preventable and reversible blindness since 1990. With a mission to strengthen eye care systems in underserved communities, more than 488 million people were impacted through the **SightFirst program** over the course of more than three decades.

December 15 – **Peace Posters and Peace Essays are due** to Council Chair, Lion Dennis Chapman.
